Membership Designations

Active Member: To be eligible as an ACTIVE member, a person shall be the full-time employee of a medical group practice consisting of three (3) or more physicians and located within the boundaries of the State of Ohio. The person must perform managerial duties in multiple areas, administrative tasks in single areas, or perform patient care and significant managerial or administrative functions within the practice.

Student Member: To be eligible as a STUDENT member, a person must be pursuing a university degree at a university within the boundaries of the State of Ohio.

Business Associate Member: To be eligible as a BUSINESS ASSOCIATE member, a person must be an employee, owner or partner of an organization involved in the supply of products, services or education to ambulatory health care professionals within the boundaries of the State of Ohio.

No one may be denied membership because of race, sex, religion, color or creed.

Membership renewal is effective on January 1st of each year. First year members pay the full membership dues, which also covers the cost of initial processing.
